Follow in the footsteps of Ofcom. Act now to secure the first memorable 03 numbers

Windsor Telecom, UK's leading provider of memorable phone numbers and inbound call solutions, is for the first time offering its customers access to select a number from the new 03 number ranges. Companies can follow Ofcom's lead who recently announced that it will be adopting new 03 prefixed phone numbers. In future consumers wanting to contact the industry regulator can call their easy to remember number 0300 123 3000.

From the 1st October, new and existing customers who act fast will have the opportunity to pick the choicest memorable 03 numbers, allocated on a first-come first-served basis. For instance, a company that manufactures rockets might choose a number such as 0333 33 54321, an Owl Sanctuary might choose 0300 28 28 20, or an audio firm could have 03330 12 12 12.

The 033 number range has been specifically allocated by Ofcom for use by any company or organisation. With 033 numbers businesses can present a positive image, where they are pro-active in responding to caller concerns with other non-geographic numbers, such as 0870. Callers can also be more confident about who they are calling.

03 numbers has been hailed as the 'magic number' by Windsor Telecom. Their introduction by Ofcom will rebuild confidence and trust in non-geographic numbers and organisations that use them. They are being introduced as an alternative to 08 business phone numbers, such as 0870 and 0871 numbers. Consumers will have a clear understanding of the price that they are paying to call 03 numbers, as the cost of calling will be the same as calls to geographic numbers (normal landline numbers starting 01 or 02).

Neil Sherring, chief executive of Windsor Telecom says: "Businesses have a great opportunity to be a part of the most talked about number range in years. It is important that companies have the confidence and trust of their customers and clients. By signing up to 03 numbers they will benefit from clearer and cheaper prices and rebuild consumer confidence for organisations, who may have been affected by the poor press around 0870 numbers. Callers can be reassured that the cost of calling these customer friendly numbers will be the same as calling standard 01 or 02 landline numbers."

Companies choosing to go 03 will be able to enjoy the valuable benefits provided by non-geographic numbers such as: instant number redirection, presenting a national identity (like 0845 numbers, 03 numbers are non-geographic), built in disaster recovery, call queuing, call statistics and information, and advanced call management.

Also in a deal exclusive to Windsor Telecom, customers will receive 10,000 free in-bound call minutes per month as part of their 03 number service plan - that's equivalent to 167 hours of inbound calls per month! Windsor's unique approach to pricing means most customers will enjoy no inbound call charges.

03 Numbers

Calls to 03 numbers will be priced in the same way as geographic numbers. Customers will pay no more to call a 03 number than they would to call a standard geographic 01 and 02 number (up to national rate).

- There are a range of 03 numbers being introduced which currently consists of:
- 0300, 0303 and 0306 are for public sector and not-for-profit organizations
- 0330 and 0333 numbers are available for any organisation or end user
- 0344, 0345, 0370, 0371 numbers will be available for migration from the equivalent 08 number i.e. 0845 can be migrated to 0345
